

LA VIEILLE VILLE – TOWN TRAIL

To complete this trail you will need a copy of the map of the Old Town

1. *There are four gates (portes) in the walls of the Old Town.*
 - a) What is the name of the gate marked [3] on your map? (also the name of the street inside the gate)
 - b) What is the maximum width for a car/lorry to get through this gate?
 - c) Can vehicles go both ways through the gates?
2. *As you walk into the Old Town you will see the library on your right.*
What are the library opening hours on Thursdays?
3. *Across the square you will see Le Beffroi (the belfry)*
 - a) There is a memorial at the bottom of it – what is it for?
 - b) How many people are mentioned?
4. The building in the main square is the Hôtel de Ville. What is it?

Which 3 flags are flying outside?

What date is inscribed on the wall behind the flags?
5. Find the notices which proclaim that Napoleon stayed in one of the houses in this square. Make a note of what the notices actually say.
6. On the opposite side of the square, you will find the Rue de Lille.
How many restaurants and crêperies are there along the Rue de Lille?*
7. What is the large building at the top (and to your left) of the Rue de Lille?
8. If you go inside the cathedral and stand underneath the dome you will see a painted scene behind the alter. Who is in the scene? (Remember that the cathedral is a place of worship, please be quiet when inside)
9. The castle (le château) is now a museum (un musée).
Find out on which year the stone over the drawbridge was laid.
(Clue M = 1000, C = 100, X = 10, V = 5, I = 1)
10. If you have time, visit the ramparts. There are 18 towers built into the walls. How many names can you find?
